## ANSA Consortium DIMMA Real Time Multi Media ORB

## Source Licence

This licence ("Licence") contains rights and restrictions associated with use of the ANSA Consortium's DI MMA software sources and documentation ("DI MMA Source"). Read the Licence carefully before installing the DI MMA Source. By installing the DI MMA Source you agree to the terms and conditions of this Licence.

1. Limited Source Licence Grant. The ANSA Consortium grants to you ("Licencee") a non-exclusive, non-transferable limited license to use the DI MMA Source without fee for evaluation of the software and for development of DI MMA compatible applications.

Licencee may make archival copies of the DI MMA Source and may re-distribute complete, unmodified copies of the DI MMA Source to software developers within Licencee's organization to avoid unnecessary download time, provided that this Licence conspicuously appear with all copies of the DI MMA Source. Except for the foregoing, Licencee may not re-distribute the DI MMA Source in whole or in part, either separately or included with a product.

- 2. DIMMA Integrity. Licencee may not modify the DIMMA Source causing the addition to or modification of the software or documentation in the Source. In the event that Licencee creates any DIMMA-related API and distributes such API to others for application development, Licencee must promptly publish an accurate specification for such API for free use by all developers of DIMMA-based software.
- 3. Licence to Distribute. Licencee is granted a royalty-free right to reproduce and distribute the compiled binary versions of the DI MMA Source (DI MMA Binary) provided that Licencee: (i) distributes binary compiled from unmodified DI MMA Source only as part of, and for the sole purpose of running, Licencee's DI MMA compatible application ("Program") into which the DI MMA Binary is incorporated; (ii) does not remove or alter any proprietary legends or notices contained in the Software; (iii) includes the provisions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 and 9 in Licencee's licence agreement for the Program; and (iv) agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and defend the ANSA Consortium and its licensors from and against any claims or lawsuits, including legal fees, that arise or result from the use or distribution of the Program. In producing DI MMA Binary from DI MMA Source, Licencee may omit entire classes from the DI MMA Source and substitute alternative implementations presenting identical interfaces for classes in the DI MMA

Source. Where classes are replaced, Licencee must state this explicitly in Licencee's licence agreement for Program.

- 4. Restrictions. DI MMA Source is confidential copyrighted information of the ANSA Consortium and title to all copies is retained by the ANSA Consortium and/or its licensors. Licencee shall not modify or extract, or otherwise reverse engineer DI MMA Source or derived DI MMA Binary. DI MMA Source may not be leased, assigned, or sublicensed, in whole or in part. DI MMA Source is not designed or intended for use in mission critical situations, including, but not limited to on-line control of aircraft, air traffic, aircraft navigation or aircraft communications, or the design, construction, operation or maintenance of any nuclear facility. Licencee warrants that it will not use DI MMA Sources or redistribute DI MMA Binary for such purposes.
- 4. Trademarks and Logos. This Licence does not authorize Licencee to use any ANSA Consortium member name, trademark or logo.
- 5. Disclaimer of Warranty. DI MMA Source is provided "AS I S," without a warranty of any kind. ALL EXPRESS OR IMPLIED REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES, INCLUDING ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR NON-INFRINGEMENT, ARE HEREBY EXCLUDED.
- 6. Limitation of Liability. THE ANSA CONSORTIUM AND LTS LICENSORS SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY DAMAGES SUFFERED BY LICENCEE OR ANY THIRD PARTY AS A RESULT OF USING OR DISTRIBUTING SOFTWARE. IN NO EVENT WILL THE ANSA CONSORTIUM OR LTS LICENSORS BE LIABLE FOR ANY LOST REVENUE, PROFIT OR DATA, OR FOR DIRECT, INDIRECT, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, INCIDENTAL OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, HOWEVER CAUSED AND REGARDLESS OF THE THEORY OF LIABILITY, ARISING OUT OF THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE SOFTWARE, EVEN IF THE ANSA CONSORTIUM HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.
- 7. Termination. Licencee may terminate this Licence at any time by destroying all copies of DI MMA Source. This Licence will terminate immediately without notice from The ANSA Consortium if Licencee fails to comply with any provision of this Licence. Upon such termination, Licensee must destroy all copies of DI MMA Source.
- 8. Export Regulations. Software, including technical data, may be subject to export or import regulations in some countries. Licencee agrees to comply strictly with all such regulations and acknowledges that it has the responsibility to obtain licenses to export, re-export, or import DI MMA Source.
- 9. Governing Law. Any action related to this Licence will be governed by English law. No choice of law rules of any jurisdiction will apply.
- 10. Severability. If any of the above provisions are held to be in violation of applicable law, void, or unenforceable in any jurisdiction, then such provisions are herewith waived to the extent necessary for the Licence to be otherwise enforceable in such jurisdiction. However, if in The ANSA Consortium's opinion deletion of any provisions of the Licence by operation of this paragraph unreasonably compromises the rights or increases the liabilities of The ANSA Consortium or its licensors, The ANSA Consortium reserves the right to terminate the Licence without remedy to the Licencee.
