

26 members of the academic staff of the University are Academic Members of CCSR



Finances

CCSR is entirely supported by industry through co-operative research programs.

→ A contract for a specific program is signed by the industry and the University.



Organisation of Programs

- → Technology transfer is the important issue. Every one of our research programs has
 - » Academic member(s) of CCSR
 - » Industrial Research Fellow(s)
 - industrial employee seconded to CCSR
 - » Post-Doctoral Fellow(s)
 - recruited especially for the program



The Level of Activity

- → At present, there are 15 people on site, 5 Industrial Research Fellows (including 2 part-time), 2 Academic Members, 6 Post-Doctoral Fellows, an administrator and a computer officer.
- Becoming 24 people by year's end.

Future Programs

(nearly approved)

- → Fault Tolerant Network Architecture
 - largely Ethernet oriented
- → Interactive, Immersive Drama
 - for education and entertainment
- → A New Paradigm for the Desktop
 - -for mobile working or browsing
- Tariffs for Dynamic Switching in ATM
 - -for providing a charged-for QoS in the network



Contractual Arrangements

- The industry supplies the funds and owns the intellectual property
 - University people have a free right to use it in further work
- Publication is encouraged
 - With a delay of up to a year for IP protection
- → A contract term is two years minimum
 - Further biennial renewals are expected
